Justice Sonia plays the queen!

A NEW DECK of cards features U.S. Supreme Court Justice Sonia Sotomayor as the Queen of Hearts in a bid to give players a hand with Hispanic heritage.

Latin Heritage Cards were released during National Hispanic Heritage Month – Sept. 15 to Oct. 15 – to provide a greater understanding of Latin culture, said Newton Paul, president of Latin Heritage Cards. “We want to educate, entertain and engage.”

Sotomayor’s card features her portrait and explains that in 2009 the Bronx native became the top court’s first Hispanic justice.

The Ace of Clubs features Jose Marti, a revolutionary who advocated Cuba’s independence from Spain, and the 10 of Diamonds depicts Mexican Cesar Chavez, who led the first farmworkers union in the U.S.
